Use of the Common Cup after 14th April and Intinction

(The following is an extraction of the Archbishops Ad_Clerum dated 8th April 2022)

Those who are at higher risk or immunocompromised should consider taking every precaution available. There should be no pressure for any communicant to receive the common cup. Please also remember that individual cups or intinction are not authorised in this diocese. It is particularly important that communicants do not intinct bread in the common cup. It has long been understood that all sorts of impurities may be on communicants' fingers and there is a significant risk of fingers coming into contact with the sacramental wine. In the current circumstance we also wish to avoid hand sanitiser contaminating the sacramental wine. Please do not permit intinction"
