What is senior Ichthus 2023?

Senior Ichthus is a six day/five night residential camp during the July school holidays. It is an exciting holiday experience that challenges young people to step outside their comfort zones through participation in group and individual activities. Senior Ichthus also gives the participants opportunities to form and strengthen new and existing friendships, and to spend time in group discussion. All of this takes place in a safe Christian community that encourages participants to meet the God who challenges us to step out and live a life of faith in Jesus. Ichthus camps have been around since 2002. Many of the leaders at these camps grew up attending them. The word Ichthus comes from Koine Greek, where it means 'fish'. In Koine Greek, it is also an acronym for "Jesus Christ, God's Son, Divine".



What can participants expect to experience?

Ichthus camps are about building community and learning about ourselves and God. The week is packed full of a range of fun, engaging and challenging activities plus uplifting worship and time to explore and reflect on faith. The week also includes messy games, authentic service activities, socialising, fun, and much, much more... and it all takes place in a safe Christian community under the guidance of a fantastic team of trained leaders.
